Teachers and FORPS have been hard at work over the last few weeks to bring plans for a celebration together. Between 28th June and 8th July, children will be investigating what school was like for children during 1870s and 1880s. By studying reference materials and 1st hand sources (the original Head's Log book) we will be aiming to learn more about

- The original school curriculum
- School uniform
- What the teachers were like
- What playtime was like
- What the attitudes of the day were and how they compare with now
- What life was like in Rusper 150 years ago.
