This term Pegasus will be exploring the text The Green Ship by Quentin Blake. The children will be writing for different purposes, including poetry writing, setting descriptions and creating a brochure. In VIPERS Guided Reading sessions, we will be continuing with 'The Boy at the Back of the Class'.

In maths, Pegasus will be working in split teaching groups to better support them for their end of year goals. Year 3s will be looking at properties of shape and statistics. Year 4s will start by spending a week of prep for the times table screen taking place on the 11<sup>th of</sup> June. Year 4s will also be looking at shape and statistics.

In this unit of learning children will be exploring the parts of the plants and what each plant does. They will be looking into concepts such as photosynthesis and look and what is needed to make a plant grow.

The children will be doing lots of practical gardening to support their learning, apologies in advance for any muddy uniforms!

Pupils will revisit learning about families. They will consider the core values of the concept of a family and know that families come in all shapes and sizes. They will explore the idea of marriage to know marriage is a formal and legal commitment and explore Christian beliefs regarding it.

Pupils will learn about core values and behaviours within relationships including, effective communication, trust, respect and manners.
