Average Scale Scores from tests

Y6 Pupils sit tests for Reading, Maths and Punctuation and Grammar. Each pupil receives a **scaled score** for each of these tests. The scaled scores are based around 100 being the average. The figures below are again an average of all the scores generated by the Y6 pupils in the cohort.

Progress

Progress is measured for each pupil across key stage 2 (years 3-6, age 7-11) from their attainment at KS1. The following figures represent an average amount of progress above or below nationally expected progress. As an average, the performance of individual pupils across the whole cohort is balanced. Schools are accountable for helping each child to make good progress (add value). Scores above zero show that a school has made good progress or 'added value'.
