Ellen Sexton	5 th Oct, 1883	Very disorderly in school
Alice Stone	30 th November	Sent home to have "attention paid to her head"
William James	11 th Jan, 1884	Joined school

Harry Short	"	Broke window at play time
William Redford	18 th Jan, 1884	Joined school
John Leadbeater	25 th Jan, 1885	Sent home with a message that his school fees were in arrears
Edward Francis	8 th Feb, 1884	Kept in after school and given task for throwing stones
Charles Sexton	"	Hit on head by stone thrown by E Francis
Eunice parker	23 rd Feb, 1884	Re-admitted to school after 10 wks absence
William Mitchell	4 th April, 1884	Broke a window during dinner hour
Harry Voice	9 th May, 1884	"
Bessie Worsfold	13 th June, 1884	Joined school
Ruth Peck	"	"
Annie Bayley	17 th Oct, 1884	Playing truant
Emma Bayley	"	"

George Marchant	21 st Nov, 1884	Reported ill, playing outside the school
Alice Riddell	15 th May, 1885	Reported as improving in arithmetic
Annie Steene	"	Reported as unable to learn arithmetic
William Ridley	24 th Sep, 1886	Struck with cane on hand and back for bad behaviour
Henrietta Imlett	12 th Oct, 1886	Showed a most violent temper when stopped getting her own way
John Fry	13 th Oct, 1886	Struck with cane on back for playing during lessons
Francis Penfold	"	Struck with cane on hand for eating apples in school
John Imlett	"	"
George Riddell	18 th Oct, 1886	Struck with cane for playing during lessons. Threatened the Headmaster that his father would take out a summons on the Head.
Annie Duff	23 rd Feb, 1887	Back classed with the Infants until fit for transfer to the 1 st standard

Chas Sexton	29 th Mar, 1887	Running among the girls being rude to them
