### **November News**

**Girl's Football:** At the time of writing the previous newsletter, Rusper Primary did not have a girl's football team. Five weeks down the line, it feels like there has always been one. The girls from Hobbit class have represented the school at two Horsham League meetings and have done incredibly well. They have learnt fast, shown very positive, happy attitudes in all the games they have played and been very well supported by parents. Big "well dones" all round.

**'Enable Me' Day:** Rusper was privileged to host a visit from the Enable Me team. Amanda, Ian, Vicki, Sam and Ben all have different disabilities. They worked with us to help pupils understand how they overcame some of the barriers they face. The activities included Wheelchair relays, Boccia (a popular game similar to Boules) and personal life stories. Rusper pupils listened carefully, asked excellent questions and learnt a lot about specific disabilities and about the resilience and successes of our guests.

**Family phonics:** A big thank you to all those parents who have attended the Family learning sessions in KS1. These times spent learning together are hugely valuable. The pupils really enjoy having a family member in the class with them; it also doubles the learning impact for the pupil as the teaching points are consistent between school and home.

**Jeremy Quin MP:** Rusper Primary was also privileged to be host to the MP for Horsham on the 3<sup>rd</sup> November. During his time at the school Mr. Quin visited every class and enjoyed speaking to all the pupils; asking them questions about British Values and democracy. He was impressed with the level of knowledge of the pupils and also with their attitudes toward learning in the classroom.

**Remembrance:** Rusper Primary was proud that members of the school choir attended the Remembrance service at St. Mary Magdalene Church. The ten-strong choir sung a simple modern piece called 'Sun Arise' to the congregation within the church. The whole service was very moving and several members of the congregation commented that the choir added a lovely dimension to the proceedings.

**Drop Off:** Unless absolutely necessary, please could KS1 parents avoid walking their child down to the classrooms in the morning. This will be both beneficial for your child's transition into the school setting and for the teacher/members of staff in your child's class as they will be either working with pupils already in school or preparing resources. If your child is upset, please bring them through the office if there is not a member of staff visible on the playground to support you. Alternative pick up arrangements should still be written on the board just inside the door. Important messages should be passed through the office, where they will then be passed directly to the teacher.
